

Dear Parents and Carers

Each year our school relies on fundraising events to help pay for many of the excellent resources we have in our school for our children. As you will all appreciate, we are more limited this year in terms of opportunities to do fundraising activities (particularly anything face to face) due to social distancing guidelines in light of COVID-19.

We would like to create a space which is simple and accessible, bright, warm and cosy for our pupils to enjoy some of their favourite books and to discover some brilliant new ones! We would like to convert Mrs Whitehouse's current office in to this space (don't worry though - she will have a comfy new spot elsewhere in school.)

It is through stories that we define our world and discover our place in it. They help us understand the world we live in, teach us about where we came from, and help us see possible futures. Stories are our education and our escape. They lull us to sleep and inspire us to action! We already have such a well-established 'reading culture' in our school and we want to build on this and give our children the opportunity to access the high quality texts which they deserve, so that they will continue to learn, develop and grow.

To help us achieve this goal, we would welcome donations from our families, friends and any local businesses you may know. Below is an indication of the possibilities... By donating you could really help us achieve something amazing for our children!

If we received £2 for every pupil:

If we received £10 for every pupil:
