Art & Design Sparks and Flames

This term we will be creating fiery art linked to Fireworks and our Great Fires topic. We will use chalks, pastels and paints to explore shades of colour across a range of different pieces of art.

Maths

Addition and Subtraction – Continuing from last term, we will build on our knowledge of addition and subtraction facts and learn how to add and subtract 2-digit numbers using different methods.

Money - We will count coin values, find totals and calculate change. We will also look at how we can spend and save and money and why/when we might do this.

Literacy **Sparks and Flames**

Poetry – we will look at a range of poetry around the theme of 'Fireworks' before creating our own poems.

Newspaper reports – Linked to our Great Fires topic, we will write newspaper reports about the fires.

History

Who was to blame for the Great Fire of London? We will investigate the events of the Great Fire of London and evaluate all the evidence to decide who was to blame for the fire. We will also learn about the Great Fire of Gateshead and compare the two events.

Computing Simple Algorithms

We will be learning about algorithms and how they are used to give a set of instructions. We will then use Code.org to practice coding and creating a debugging simple programs.

What is bullying? We will learn that we are all different and be able to recognise how words and actions can affect how people feel. Our No Outsiders text is 'Can I Join Your Club?' by John Kelly.
